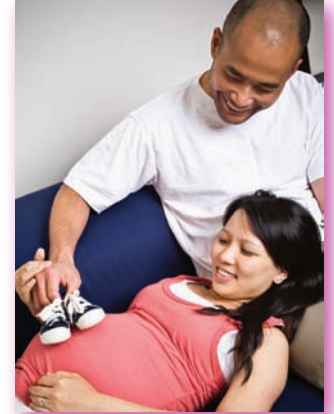


PRO-CHOICE SCORECARD 2009

Each year, dozens of measures that affect our rights and our lives come before the California State Legislature. Our elected officials make decisions about the right to choose a safe and legal abortion, access to reproductive health care and much more.

Planned Parenthood Affiliates of California (PPAC) advocates for a wide range of issues and usually scores votes on legislation affecting access to reproductive health care including family planning services, comprehensive sex education, and other clinical services.

In 2009, an unprecedented budget deficit required the Legislature to prioritize budget negotiations. The intensity of these negotiations resulted in fewer policy bills than in prior years. In addition, the budget constraints caused most bills with significant cost to the state to fail. This trend will likely continue through the next several years because of the poor economic forecast.



During the 2009 legislative year, there were a few measures that would have directly affected Planned Parenthood's services and mission. The 2009 Pro-Choice Scorecard scores only these few votes, rather than the comprehensive range of policy issues advocated for by Planned Parenthood.

Description of Issues Scored

Senate Budget Bill: Family Planning Funding

An anti-choice amendment to the state budget that would prohibit state funding of family planning service providers.

Assembly Nursing Facilities Bill: Abortion Funding

Four anti-choice amendments, unrelated to the subject of the bill, that would do the following: 1) limit state funding for abortion services, 2) ban certain abortion procedures, 3) require parental consent before a minor can access abortion care, and 4) provide biased information to women before they can access abortion care.
